



Publication Ethics

The editorial board of the journal is responsible for and strives for the maintenance of a code of publication ethics as well as for the copyright of published works.

The editorial board evaluates the scientific quality of the articles regardless of race, gender, country of residence, ethnicity, affiliation, religion, or sexual orientation of the author(s). Editorstake measures to detect and prevent the publication of such articles that violate the research ethics and if necessary provide corrections, clarifications, or rejections.

Each submitted article undergoes a double-blind peer review. The review process is rigorous and may take 1-2 months. A reviewer can reject a paper, suggest minor or major revisions, or guarantee straight to publication. If the article is accepted, it is published according to a prescribed order.

The review process by the experts is carried out with the following principles:

- the article must be free from plagiarism and self-plagiarism,
- the article should be related to any of the scientific directions of the journal,
- the article must contain scientific novelty,
- the article must include an abstract and keywords in 3 languages (Armenian, Russian, and English),
- the article must meet the technical requirements of the journal.

If the reviewers consider that they do not have the appropriate skills to review the given article, they immediately inform the editorial office, rejecting the offer to review. The articles accepted for review are confidential documents and can not be shared or discussed with third parties without the editorial office's permission. The publication in the journal is free, no submission charges or page charges are applied. All published articles are available online, free to read, download, and share.

The journal's policy allows authors to maintain the copyright of their articles.
